2 HEALTH ACTIVITIES

Medical/Dental Mission & Ayaw ku-to!

God has once again brought people together to minister to the physical needs of His children.

A dental/medical mission was held last July 7, 2012 for the Hands-to-Street-Kids (HSK) Las Pinas area at the Golden Acres School. Three groups: Rayomar Outreach Foundation, Inc., Kaagapay Foundation and RYMI made the event possible. The people were required to register first, undergo counseling to address firstly their spiritual health. Vital signs then were taken before anyone can avail of the dental and/or medical services. 350 patients were served. Prescribed medicines were also given for free. Special haircut services courtesy of Ricky Reyes Foundation, Inc. (RRFI) were also provided. 3 big casseroles of healthy vegetable soup were cooked and served hot to the children at the school.



A soft launching for a new health program was done at Mascardo and Montojo area.

Please Fleas Flee! or "Ayaw ku-to!" was held for 2 consecutive Saturdays (Aug 25 and 31). Dra. Catalan gave an orientation to 156 clients, children and their parents, about 'Fleas' possible causes and suggested prevention. Treatment was provided by using a special shampoo. Shampoo rubbed to the scalp and allowed to stay for 10 mins. Hair was then rinsed, dried then combed with a fine-toothed comb, also known locally as "suyod," to remove the remaining nits. The Makati Fire Department made this possible by providing the much needed water.
