Cabuyao and Cuyab Laguna Relief Operations

Truly our God is generous to multiply the blessings where 200 families were given clothes and relief packs each consisting of rice, canned goods, instant noodles, biscuits, detergents and fabric conditioner. RYMI also served soup with hard-boiled eggs and juice for 1000 kids and adults. The beneficiaries of the relief operations were quick to express their gratitude to the Lord. More than these items, the hope, faith, trust and reassurance that kind, caring and loving people still do exist is the most important message that was imparted to the people that day. No amount of rain could dampen the hearts of those who came.
